People: **We will challenge it, we will speak out, we will do to ease the fear.**

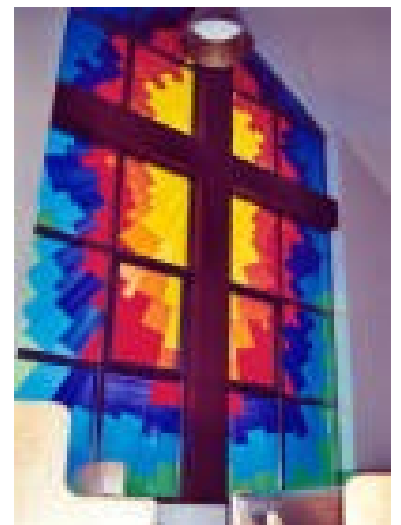
Leader: Where there is joy and hope,

 for life and the world. Amen.

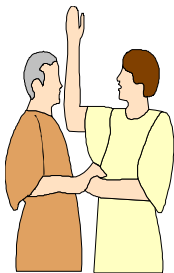
Offertory Hymn
